ADA and Website Accessibility

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990 is a civil rights law that prohibits discrimination against individuals with disabilities in all areas of public life. The US Department of Justice released the 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design, which extends to include websites as well.

Organizations including online retailers and government agencies, are encouraged to use Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0 as a guideline to eliminate discrimination and achieve accessibility.

WCAG 2.0 provides three levels of guidelines for accessibility – Level A, Level AA and Level AAA, and is grouped under 4 principles – Perceivable, Operable, Understandable and Robust.
